### REPORT

2nd national CME of ACOIN "Talk Ophtha at Shantiniketan" has been successfully completed jointly by ACOIN (Association of Community Ophthalmologists of India) and IROPA (Indian Railway Ophthalmic Physician Association) at Maharshi Niwas, Bolpur during Saturday and Sunday 28th February and 1st March 2015.

Prof. Sushanta Datta Gupta, Vice Chancellor, Visvs Bharati inaugurated the CME. Dr. Shyam Sunder, Medical Director, B. R. Singh Railway Hospital graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Prof. R. R. Sukul, President, ACOIN joined from Aligarh and presided the whole ceremony.
